Born in the historic city of Xi'an, China, Chinese American conductor **Shun Yao** currently serves as the assistant conductor of Annapolis Symphony Academy and music director of the UMD University Orchestra.

An experienced conductor of broad repertoire and interests, Shun Yao has worked with professional and student orchestras across Europe,

Asia, and the United States. His programs often consist of a wide variety of composers from CPE Bach, Carlos Simon, to Unsuk Chin and John Williams. His 2017 performance of selections from Prokofiev's *Romeo and Juliet* was described as "great attention to phrasing" and "conveyed the tender nature of the work" by *Classical Voice* (NC). In 2023, Mr. Yao was one of the conductors selected by Paavo and Neeme Järvi to perform with Järvi Academy Youth Orchestra which was broadcasted by the Estonian national television.

Mr. Yao received his degrees from Manhattan School of Music, Rice University, and Cleveland Institute of Music, and is currently a DMA candidate at University of Maryland studying with Maestro David Neely.
