Tim Powell received his Bachelor of Science in music education from Penn State University, a Master of Music in jazz studies and a Doctor of Musical Arts in saxophone performance from the University of Maryland, College Park. The focus of his doctoral studies included electro-acoustic music for saxophone, as well as contemporary saxophone sonatas. He has commissioned and premiered several works for the saxophone.

Powell is currently on faculty at Rowan University and the University of Maryland. He has also served on the faculties of the Pennsylvania State University, Frostburg State University, Montgomery College and Anne Arundel Community College.
